* The range shown by the arrows on the Fluid Service Chart is based on type of operation the vehicle is subjected to. The lower number represents vehicles operated under *severe* operating conditions. The higher number is for normal service.

☞ If you drive **short trips**, you should consider that the vehicle is being operated under *severe* service. We define short trips as less than ten miles each direction. If this is the type of service your vehicle is subjected to, follow the lower number represented by the left hand side of the arrow.

☞ If you drive **more than ten miles** per trip (normal service), follow the right hand end of the arrow. The further you drive for each trip that you take, the longer the service interval or the greater the mileage interval shown by the arrow.

☞ If you drive a **mix of short and longer trips**, you will find your replacement interval somewhere in the middle of the arrow.

☞ The intervals for time and mileage should be followed as to *whichever comes first*.
